From the outbreak of epidemic beginning from the end of 2019, the work of the Association has been greatly affected and the China projects are closed and ended, due to the inability to reach and restrictions, Due to the leaving of the Chairman and the Vice Chairman and also the Change of the C.E.O. by the end of March 2021, we then, have to manage to focus all the time, on providing limited services and limited assistance for Hong Kong communities. The fight for the ride over the epidemics are the main focus, spiritual & psychological healing and poverty alleviation work had to be carried out all the year round in Hong Kong. We still cooperated with Chinese medicine Practitioner to provide limited free Chinese medicine diagnosis and treatment services. In addition, the services to the industrial and accidental injuries and casualties have also been implemented as there are 50,000 thousand case each year in Hong Kong.

I sincerely hope that the epidemic will pass as soon as possible, so that our works in mainland China and Hong Kong can return to normal. May our God bless all the people in China and Hong Kong !

2. Words from Chief Executive : Elder Constant Kam

Under the circumstance of limited resources, sent volunteer Counselors 2021 to persuade young people not to be overly emotional and to act aggressively, and to follow good guidance, hoping to provide counseling with love and the spirit of Christ. In early 2020, when the epidemic broke out, it was imperative to distribute supplies to the elderly. Although without any outer funding, we continue to provide limited works for alleviation of both spiritual, moody needs and the shortage of supplies for those in need. We are also very grateful to our partners for providing free TCM clinics, 天人中醫館 and Mr Wong from 山友育樂協會. Hope to continue to cooperate in the future, the Lord's grace is overflowing.

3. Introduction

Our organization Founded on April 30, 2009, it was initiated by Pastor Wu Xiaohu, Pastor Chen Zhuoli, Liu Huiru, Ye Zhanxi, Feng Anni, etc. It is a Hong Kong registered charity organization (IRD 91/10203)

Our Aims : We are a Christian charity organization, serving the society with the love of Jesus Christ, caring for and supporting the poor and aggrieved people due to natural disasters, caring for some abandoned children, and supporting vulnerable groups and people. Our Mission :

1. To promote humanitarianism, promote social fairness and justice,
2. Helping the disadvantaged groups, sponsor orphans, community support, nurturing the younger generation.
3. Disaster relief and poverty alleviation, and promote social enterprises.

Clients of service: Disaster relief and Poverty alleviation, poor and aggrieved people, orphans and the elderly, industrial/accidental injuries and vulnerable groups.

Our source of income: We are a Hong Kong-registered charitable organization, and our funds are mainly donated to Christian believers and people from all walks of life.

The Structure of the Association:

The highest is the General Meeting, the next is the board of directors and the advisory group. Below the Board of Directors are the Executive Board, under which are the Chief Executive and Deputy Executive, which manages the Administration Department (including administration and accounting), the Caring & Services Department and the Promotion Department (including fund raising and publicity).

In addition, the Chief Executive is also in charge of planning, future developments of all the above social services and administration departments. Whose works includes accounting, budgets of our organizations sponsorship, raising funds, poverty alleviation, and other extensive community services and supports.

5. Main Services and Activities our organization 2020-2021 :-

Community supports and Assistance :

Mainly implement and in charged by our duty Chief Executive elders Constant H.N. Kam and Assistance

Chief(volunteer)Dr.Lo Kwun Cheung to handle the requests and cases. A total about 50 people are being assisted, including supports and assistance for newly arrived mainland immigrants, elderly, grassroots, and the vulnerably groups' people including the industrial/accidental casualties, applying for unemployment benefits, social security Aids, legal Aids and other professional assistance. Further more, Requests for emotional counseling,clinic escort etc.

The Supports and Services are undertaken as followings : -

A. Legal Consultation and Assistance (about 50 beneficials)

These services are provided Mr. Qiu Zhiqiang(Solicitor), volunteer legal adviser of our Association, for free legal consultation, and Elders Constant H.N. Kam and Dr.Lo Kwun Cheung are the helpers in handling with the clients and requests.

B. Prays and Cares(about 50 are benefited)

Cooperated with the Lutheran Church for the Deaf and the Christian Church, held several missions and prayer meetings from June to August 2020, prayed for the safety of our city, and opened the church on the first floor of No. 780 Nathan Road, Mong Kok That house provides rest and prayers for young people to pray for the blessings of Hong Kong.

C. Care for the Industrial/Accidental Casualties(about 50 are benefited)

Cooperated with Concerted Efforts Rehabilitation Center to provide support and cares for the industrial/accidental casualties (there about 50 thousands cases occurred every years in Hong Kong)

D. Spiritual and Mood Healing and Consultations (about 100 are benefited)

Cooperated with Christian Church of Chinese Ministry and 恩祐基督教會 to provide spiritual and mood

healing and Consultations via Zoom/Whatsapp/Wechat(微信)/Hotlines/sms as well as face to face interview. Provide same group Talks, Lectures and Seminars with live video conferences.E. Poverty Alleviation Activities(Visit and Cares)(about 100 are benefited)

Leading by Lutheran Rev. Chen Jincheng, from September to October 2020 in mainly in Wang Tau Hom

and Kwun Tong Districts, Kowloon, every Saturday afternoon, Out reach teams are sent out to visit the needy people living in the above two Districts. Hygienic and epidemic prevention materials, canned food and daily necessities will be given to vulnerable groups and the elderly aged near or over 65.

F. Community Healthy Cares (with totally over 100 people benefited including young and old clients)

a, Talks and Seminar (small groups)

Co-organized with New Hope Cancer Centre, on September 20, 2019, a lecture on cancer prevention

and healthy living was held at Room C, 1/F, 780 Nathan Road, Mong Kok. Chinese medicine practitioner Leung Po Heng conducted a lecture on diet therapy and the causes of various cancers.

b, Limited free Chinese Medicine Clinic From April 2021 to March 2022

Free Chinese medicine clinic are being held every Sunday afternoon at Vitality Chinese Medicine Clinic :

G. Fighting the Epidemic Together

A. Continue to purchase masks, disinfectants and other materials, and distribute them to the elderly in public housing estates to fight the epidemic together.(about 100 are benefited)

B. Cooperated with Chinese Medicine Practitioners, like 元氣中醫館 and 天人中醫館 to provide face interview as well as distance healing and consultation(about 100 are benefited including young and the elders)

C. Cooperated with 山友育樂協會 in order to provide picnics and visiting to countrysides to provide nature healing and physical wellness activities. There about 100 beneficial(including young and the elders).

D. Supporting the orphanages children in Asian country (about 50 are benefited)

Since seriously affected by the pandemic, this project in mainland china has almost stopped. With the help of the local churches in Philippines and Burma, we begin to start assistance the orphanages.(Children mainly are handicaps) in the country around Asia.

6. Future Plans

A. First of all, it is an indisputable fact that young people lack care in Hong Kong. No matter what political stance they have, the society should first understand their needs and thoughts, Thus, provide assistance and proper guidance instead of giving up and punishing them. The Association hopes to do more activities in the future to assist them in their further studies and spiritual advancement.

B. A place of about 6,000 sq feet space in west Kowloon district in order to build the "New Heaven & New World" Community Hall has been chosen and documents are prepared for applications to the related Govt. Departments.

C. Collaboration with more other NGOs like Hong Kong The Mental Health Association to open Mental Health First Aid Certificate Course(Internationally recognized)to provide more effective and fullness physical and mental health for the youngsters and invulnerable people.

D. We are going to establish a ""Body, Mind, Social & Spiritual Diversity Therapy Center"身心社靈多元治療中心. And also open courses on Community Ambassador & Volunteer Leader Training Courses to teach ESG & Sq(Spiritual Quotient) for the young volunteers and care takers in Hong Kong.



E. In addition to traditional Chinese medicine free clinic services and countryside visiting, we plan to develop garden therapy, music, art therapy and psychological, spiritual & mood healing for the needy persons.

F. Integrate and advocate the concept and elements of “ “Social Participate & Social Interactive ability” , and S.Q. Into the psychological teachings and cirrcumums.

G. Training, empowering and actualizing the youngsters, Carers and volunteers to be a good and responsible Community Counseling Ambassadors and Volunteer Leaders.

Finally, due to the enormous challenges and difficulties, we and all Hong Kong people have to face in this year, as a Christian charitable NGO, I hope that through all these above services and programs, as we walk and work together, the physical and mental health of vulnerable groups, youngsters and the senior persons can be improved, recover and keep safe.

At this difficult time, we must strengthen our faith and pray in order to make Hong Kong a more caring, a safe international city that can embraces and understands each other, not a city that attacks each other, scolds each other, and fighting against each other.
